

How to make a submission on the Saint Elmo Project Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)

Under the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* (EP Act) anyone can have their say during the EIS public notification period.

All stakeholders, interested persons and groups, and the public are invited to make submissions on the Saint Elmo Project EIS during the EIS public notification period. Submissions can be made on any aspect of the EIS and can be positive, negative or neutral, all submissions are welcome.

The EIS will be available on the Project website (<http://saintelmoproject.com.au>) for people to review the documents and provide a submission. Submissions must be received between the 4th of November and 16th of December 2019.

Properly Made Submission

If you decide to make a submission on the EIS, it must be 'properly made', meaning the submission must:

- be written;
- signed by the writer(s);
- state the name and address of each writer;
- be made to the Chief Executive; and
- be received on or before the last day of the submission period.

The Department of Environment and Science (DES) recommend using the EIS submission template provided on their website (<https://www.qld.gov.au/environment/pollution/management/eis-process/projects/have-your-say-on-an-eis>) to assist with preparing a submission.
